INTRODUCTION TO ART

Figure and form - Childhood Idyll by Bouguereau

Friday 24 June; Friday 1 & 8 July 2022

This class runs over three weeks. We will explore figure and form in young children, inspired by a beautiful painting by William Bouguereau. In the first class you will plan the composition and draw a light sketch in graphite pencils. In the second class you will work in the tones and details in pastel or charcoal, and in the third class you will introduce colour with pastel pencils.


